## Tuition Schedule for the 2026-27 School Year

We recommend that SMHS families avail themselves of the **St. Michael Education Loan offered through St. Francis Xavier Credit Union**. This 12-month, 6.00% APR loan is obtainable at any branch in about 15 minutes with a tuition statement issued by the school. The Education Loan can help families pay tuition upfront and benefit from discounted rates, as shown in the table below. Please call the SFXCU main office at 231.348.7690 to initiate the loan application process.

### 2026-27 Tuition Rates For Full-Time Students

<b><u>Paid...</u></b>	<b><u>in-full by May 31</u></b>	<b><u>in-full by Aug 15</u></b>	<b><u>monthly</u></b>
One Student	\$6,750	\$7,000	\$7,500
Two Students	\$11,500	\$12,000	\$13,000
Three Students	\$14,750	\$15,500	\$17,000

A minimum ‘tuition deposit’ of \$500 per student is due by May 31.

Families can ‘lock in’ the 2025-26 tuition rate by paying in-full by August 15 and can pay *less than* the 2025-26 tuition rate by paying in-full by May 31.

If paying tuition monthly, payments are due on the 15th of each month from August to May.

Tuition includes all books as well as fees for St. Michael sponsored athletics teams. Families are responsible for costs and fees for ‘Co-op’ athletics teams (hosted by other schools), certain extracurricular activities, field trips, and standardized tests.

***For homeschoolers...*** Tuition for Part-Time students is essentially ‘pro rata’, relative to Full-Time tuition rates. Tuition rates for Lyceum students are provided on a separate schedule.

### **Tuition Assistance**

Families seeking Tuition Assistance (a.k.a. Financial Aid) may apply for need-based scholarships by completing an application via VentureEd Solutions. Tuition Assistance applications for returning SMHS families are due by May 31.
