Tuition Schedule for the 2026-27 School Year

We recommend that SMHS families avail themselves of the **St. Michael Education Loan offered through St. Francis Xavier Credit Union**. This 12-month, 6.00% APR loan is obtainable at any branch in about 15 minutes with a tuition statement issued by the school. The Education Loan can help families pay tuition upfront and benefit from discounted rates, as shown in the table below. 2026-27 Tuition Rates For Full-Time Students

<u>Paid...</u>	<u>in-full by Aug 15</u>	<u>monthly</u>
One Student	\$7,000	\$7,500
Two Students	\$12,000	\$13,000
Three Students	\$15,500	\$17,000

- ♦ Families can 'lock in' last year's tuition rate by paying in-full by August 15.
- ♦ A minimum 'tuition deposit' of \$500 per full-time student is due upon enrollment.
- ♦ If paying tuition monthly, payments are due on the 15th of each month from August to May.

Tuition includes all books. Students incur no fees for St. Michael sponsored athletic teams, but families are responsible for all costs and fees incurred for 'Co-op' athletic teams (hosted by other schools) - as well as for certain extracurricular activities, field trips, and standardized tests.

For homeschoolers... Tuition for part-time students is essentially 'pro rata', relative to full-time students. Per class tuition is provided on a separate schedule. Tuition rates for Lyceum students are also provided on a separate schedule.
